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Principals Update

Dear Junction Family,

Thank you for partnering with us this school year to overcome the pandemic and associated circumstances. We worked together to keep our community safe and our kids in school. Other than a two-week hiatus in February, our students benefited from full-time, in-person instruction throughout the school year. Our team worked tirelessly this year to make sure that students developed academically, socially, emotionally and physically, but even though the school year is coming to an end, these efforts are only continuing to ramp up.

Beginning June 2nd, our Junction Summer Program begins and will continue through July 2nd. Students will be inventing, engineering, researching, showcasing and playing as they participate in this program highlighted by the National Inventors Hall of Fame's *Camp Invention*. We are also pleased to be offering bus transportation, morning care beginning at 7:30, breakfast and lunch during the school day, and after school care until 5pm. Students will also be introduced to the Edgenuity program to beef up ELA and math skills over the summer, so that they avoid the "summer slide" and hit the ground running next school year!

As our team heads into the summer, we are also working extremely hard to get ready for next year. Additional COVID relief funds are allowing us to expand our program, adding new instructional materials, new online programs and new staff. We have hired a new middle school teacher, we are interviewing elementary teachers, and we are seeking applications for a new music/band teacher as well as several instructional aide positions. If there is anyone reading this note that thinks they might be interested in joining our Junction team as an aide, but would like more information, please take a look at the positions posted on Edjoin.org and feel free to contact me directly for more information.

Finally, while we have not received official guidance from the state, all signs are pointing toward a better next school year. We plan to have full day kindergarten; we are hoping to fully implement and expand our clubs, extracurricular activities, sports and electives; we hope to see parent volunteers back on campus; and we are expecting to see a relaxation of safety protocols and a resumption of our favorite community building events. Again, we do not know exactly what the future holds, but we will be planning for great things and a great new school year. Keep an eye out for continued school updates in June, July and August and have a wonderful, family-filled summer!

Summer School Information

Hello Junction Families,

We have been busy finalizing details of our Summer School program for you! At last, we have worked out the details regarding transportation, aftercare cost and time, and office hours. **There are still a few limited spots available for this opportunity, so please contact the office now if you are interested.**

Bus services may be utilized to arrive at Junction by 8am, and to leave school at 12:35 pm. Those using the bus must be at an in-district stop. Students TK through 2nd grade age must be greeted by an adult to be allowed off the bus in the afternoon.

Aftercare will be offered Monday through Friday until 5pm, at a \$45 per student, weekly flat rate, from June 7th through July 2nd. You will not be charged for weeks your student does not attend.

Breakfast will be offered from 8am until 8:25am. Please do not drop off students before 8am, as we do not have staff available for supervision before that time. Lunch will be served prior to all students' dismissal.

Our office clerk will be on campus from 8am until 12:30pm. Please call in by 9am if your student will not be attending. If you need to change your students' after school destination, please call by 11am. We cannot guarantee successful destination changes requested after 11am, so please try your best to communicate ahead of time if there will be changes in your schedule.
