Temporary Cell Phone Possession Special Permit

My student, _____, has permission to bring a cellphone to school. Myself and my student both understand the following conditions apply to this privilege:

- Carrying a cell phone at Junction School is a privilege, and Junction School is not responsible for damage, loss, or theft of any device.
 - All students carrying cell phones must have a cell phone permit on file in the office.
 - Cell phones cannot be used before school or during the day. *
 - Students may use cell phones after the last bell of the day.
 - Cell phones must be turned in at the beginning of the school day and students may reclaim them at dismissal.
- The student and parent/guardian are aware that permission is a special exception to the district policy regarding electronic devices. Use of cell phones during school hours is a disruption of school activities.
- The student and the parent/guardian are aware that a cell phone is a valuable personal item and that the school assumes no responsibility for the theft/damage.
- If the student violates the terms of this permit by disrupting class with the device, having the device out and in use during the school day, or allowing another student to use the device, they will be subject to the consequence as outlined on the reverse of this contract.

Consequences for misuse of cell phone

Loss of permit means you cannot have a phone at school.
The term “cellphone” means any device that may be used for calling or texting.

Students are not permitted to use non-school devices during school hours.
